



Blended Learning (Learning from Home)



Non- Negotiables: Children & Parents

Single or Group Isolation:

Single or group isolation is when an individual child or group is isolating. If this happens, it is important that you are able to complete the same learning as your peers in school.

When isolating, you must:

- Log on to the school website and check your timetable, every day
- Follow your timetable, making sure that you click the correct link on the correct day (Lesson 1- Monday, Lesson 2- Tuesday etc.)
- Make sure that you take your breaks, do some exercise and drink plenty of water
- Upload your learning to Seesaw on the day that it is set, so that your teacher can give you feedback. You can complete your learning on paper and upload a photograph, or complete it on your Seesaw journal. **Remember to include the date and lesson title**
- Join your partner year group bubble, if they are on whole class isolation and partake in their lessons
- Take pride in your learning and follow the school's presentation and behaviour expectations.

Parents must call the school office, as if their child were absent from school, if children will not be completing learning for any reason.

Whole Class Isolation

Whole class isolation is when the whole class is isolating and cannot be in school. If this happens, we will be completing our lessons online, together.

When isolating, you must:

- Log on to the school website and check your timetable, every day
- Follow the links on the school website timetable to access our class Teams lessons, making sure that you log on a few minutes before so lessons can start promptly
- Make sure that you have a pen/pencil and pieces of paper
- Make sure that you are the only person on screen and that you are in an appropriate place in your house, wearing appropriate clothing
- Listen carefully to your instructions and use the 'raise hand' function if you have any questions. You will be set a task after your short Teams lesson.
- Upload your learning to Seesaw on the day that it is set, so that your teacher can give you feedback. You can complete your learning on paper and upload a photograph, or complete it on your Seesaw journal
- Take pride in your learning and follow the school's presentation and behaviour expectations.
- If you miss a live lesson, a recording of the live lesson will be posted on Seesaw.
