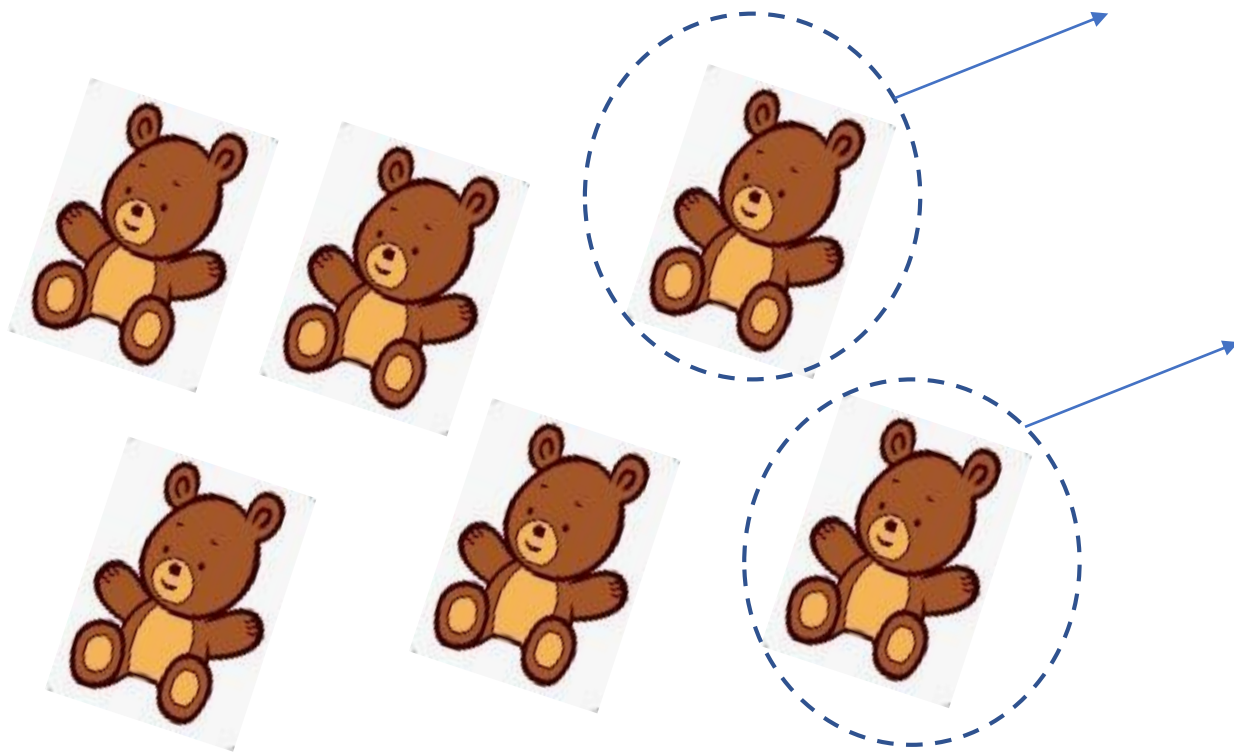
Addition strategies

Subtraction strategies

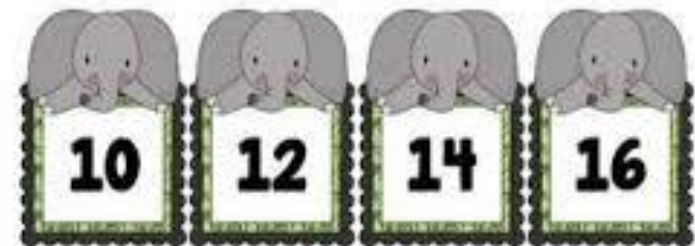
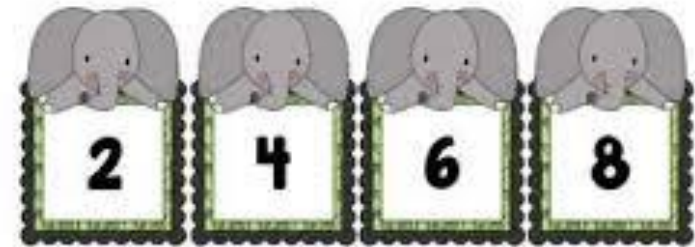
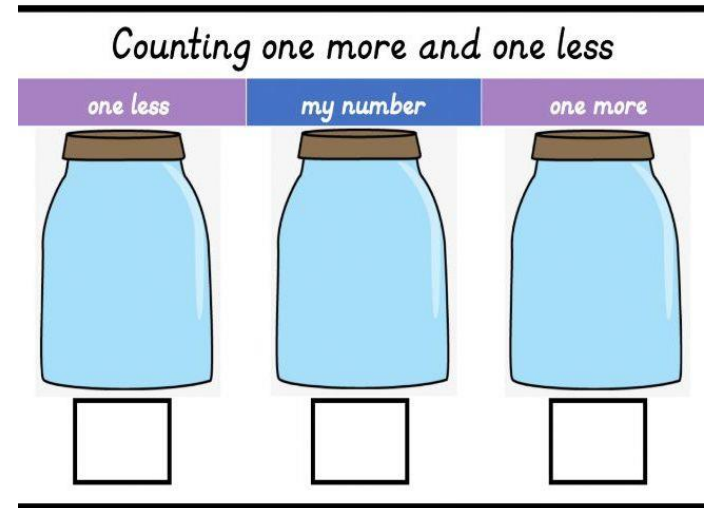
Practically getting a set of objects and removing some (up to 20)

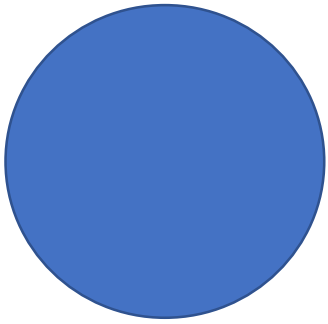
Other strategies to practise...

- Counting beyond 20

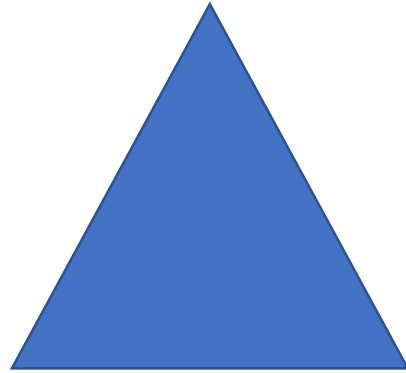
