At Lightwoods, we realise that all staff; whether paid or voluntary; have a duty to keep young people safe and to protect them from sexual, physical or emotional harm. Children have the right to be safe and to be treated with respect and dignity. Therefore, trusted adults are expected to take reasonable steps to ensure the safety and well-being of pupils.

Failure to do so may be regarded as professional neglect. All staff are expected and encouraged to disclose and record any concerns without any fear of any recourse or consequences to them for their actions in doing so.

Any concerns relating to Safeguarding must be reported to the Designated Safeguarding Lead at the earliest possible opportunity. They are fully responsible for liaising with local statutory children’s agencies, as appropriate. The Head Teacher/DSL are also responsible for ensuring that staff members have regular and appropriate training relating to Safeguarding Children.

Lightwoods Primary School is part of Sandwell's Operation Encompass. This is the early reporting to school when a child has been exposed to domestic violence or domestic abuse.
