10 minutes	Practise writing your first and last name, making sure you form your letters correctly, see sheet given on how to form letters, mainly starting from the top.
1 hour	<p>English - Read Jack and the Beanstalk if you don't have a copy of the story; https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=rKB1_wBueFM Discuss the story, what was your favourite part and why, who was your favourite character, why, who didn't you like, why? Can you order the story using sheet provided - sequencing story or if you can't print draw pictures to show the sequence of the story.</p> <p>Knowledge and Understanding of the World - Have you been watching the inspirational story of Captain Tom and how much money he has raised for our NHS. Maybe you could make him a card for his 100th Birthday or design him a new medal to say thank you for all the money he has raised.</p>

20 min	Order the Jack and Beanstalk alphabet Can you sing the alphabet, google 'boom shake the alphabet' by Mr Mc, one of our favourites.
1 hour	<p>Maths - Height What is taller than you? Shorter than you? Name 5 things. Order the characters from Jack and the beanstalk in height order using the sheet provided. What do we use to measure objects? Play this game https://www.topmarks.co.uk/early-years/lets-compare</p> <p>Number - Counting to 50/100, play some counting games on education city https://www.education.com/</p>

Read your reading book or one of the books you have at home. 1 hour	<p>Child Initiated Time Choose some activities which are based around your children's interests Colouring pictures from Jack and the Beanstalk, painting pictures from the story, build your own castle.
