Thursday - St. George's Day

Duration	Thursday - St. George's Day
10 minutes	Practise writing your first and last name, making sure you form your letters correctly.
1 hour	English/Knowledge and Understanding of the World. Watch and find out about the legend of St. George https://www.storynory.com/st-george-and-the-dragon/ https://youtu.be/OFTgSaTST_E Discuss the story and describe the dragon. Children could draw a picture of the dragon and George and write or copy a short sentence or colour in and write some words on the sheets provided.
BREAK (remember to have a snack!)	
20 min	<u>Spelling/handwriting practise</u> Can you spell I, no, the, to, go, into' if you like try and write a sentence with the words in.
1 hour	<u>Maths</u> Go through the adding powerpoint that is included. Complete St George Day adding sheet. Make up your own adding number problems.
LUNCH (make sure you also get some fresh air if you can!)	
30 minutes	<u>Reading/Phonics</u> Please see Oxford Reading Owl https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/reading/ for additional e-books based at your child's reading level (see book colour band.) Read phonics flash cards, phase 2/3 clip on Twitter with Mrs. Jones Play phonics games phase 2/3 on phonics bloom https://www.phonicsbloom.com/
1 hour	<u>Child Initiated Time</u> Choose some activities which are based around your children's interests Play Dragons and knights, make a dragon, draw and paint St. George. Make St George flag to put in your window.
