30 minutes	Body Coach 'PE with Joe' (YouTube)
15 minutes	Read your reading book... Activity: Read the book aloud to a partner or family member. Ask them to tell you 2 good things about your reading and 2 ways to improve your reading. Take their feedback on board and then re-read the text again to them.
1 hour	<b>Maths</b> <a href="https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/">https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/</a> Select Year 5 > Summer Term Week 1 Lesson 5: Friday maths challenge <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Watch the video and then attempt the questions.</li></ul> Ask an adult to look through your answers and discuss anything you found difficult.

20 min	<b>Spelling: Words containing the letter string 'ough'</b> <b>though, although, dough, doughnut, through, cough, trough, rough, tough, enough</b> Test yourself - ask an adult to read the ten spelling words to you, then check how many you got right!
1 hour	<b>English: Talk for Writing Unit - "The Game" (p12-p13 in unit document)</b> Re-read the story carefully Answer comprehension questions 7-12

20 minutes	<b>Reading for pleasure</b> Get comfy and become absorbed in a good book!
1 hour	<b>CURRICULUM</b> <b>Science - Animals and their habitats</b> Read about the life cycles of 3 different amphibians: frogs, salamanders and axolotls. Either print, cut and stick or draw the different stages of each life cycle.
