- How many times can you hop on one leg in 1 minute?
- What number can you write up starting from 0 in 1 minute?
- Can you think of something else to time yourself doing?
- Can you be silent for 1 minute? (mums and dads, you might want to change the timer for this one!)

For an extra challenge; write some special words you will use in your version of the story. For example, describing words for your caterpillar like, sleepy, wriggly, hairy, stripy. Use special words to describe the food he ate or the creatures he met. Make the language as descriptive as possible!
